

Create a Pop-Up Window For a Graphic Using Expression

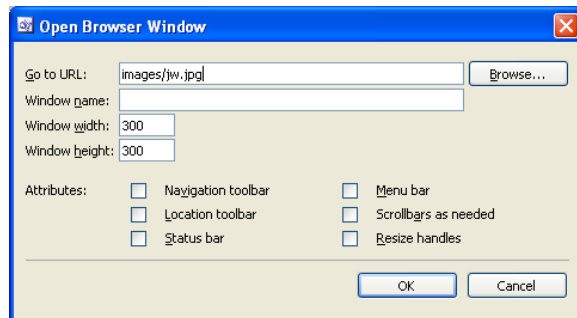


On a website there are often pictures which would look better if enlarged. Creating a thumbnail works but it may be better to see the image in a custom sized window and as a separate window.

To prepare this you need a web page with a link that when clicked on will open the window. You also need a jpg picture and know the size of the image.

Steps:

1. Open Expression and select the image or text which when clicked on will cause the pop-up window to appear
2. Select the object
3. From the Format Menu select Behaviors
4. In the Behaviors Task Pane Select Insert an then choose Open Browser Window
5. Set options as needed



Options:

Go To URL	The URL of the graphic to open
Window Name	Left blank creates a new blank window
	You can set a frameset name for other with one of the following values:
	_blank new unnamed window
	_media page appears in html content area of media bar
	_parent page appears in the current frame's parent
	_search page appears in browsers search pane
	_self replaces the current page in the same window
	_top replaces any already loaded framesets
Window Width	How wide the pop-up will be
Window Height	How high the pop-up window will be
Attributes	Navigation bar – display browsers navigation toolbar (back – forward)
	Location toolbar – display input field for browser
	Status bar – status bar at bottom of window
	Menu bar – display browsers menu bar
	Scroll bars – display horizontal & vertical scroll bars
	Resize handles – provides resize handles
